Notice is hereby given that an Initial Study of Environmental Impacts and Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration have been prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act and are available for public review for:

Conditional Use Permit 2016-01/Verizon Bishop Plaza LLC

The applicant has applied for a CUP to install a 70' mono-pine tower to house nine panel 6' tall antennas and two 6' tall microwave antennas to increase the capacity of the existing Verizon Wireless network in the area as well as to respond to increasing numbers of customer complaints. The proposed project site is the back parking lot at the Bishop Plaza shopping center, located at 1351 Rocking W Drive, Bishop, CA 93514

The 21-day review period for this Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact begins on February 10, 2016 and expires on March 2, 2016. During this period comments may be submitted regarding the Initial Study and Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration. Inyo County is not required to respond to any comments received after this date.
