5. **AMENDED RECLAMATION PLAN NO. 2007-03/CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (INDEPENDENCE PIT) (Public Hearing and Action Item)** – The California State Department of Transportation (CALTRANS), with the permission from the Bureau of Land Management, is requesting an amendment of Reclamation Plan No. 97-76. CALTRANS is proposing to extend the time period of use from 5 years to 10 years; increase material mining from 550,000 cubic yards to 1.2 million cubic yards; and allow for the placement of a portable asphalt plant within the material site only during periods of construction of planned highway 4-lane projects.
