If an appeal is filed, there is a fee of \$300.00. Appeals and accompanying fees must be delivered to the Clerk of the Board Office at County Administrative Center Independence, California. If you challenge in court any finding, determination or decision made pursuant to a public hearing on a matter contained in this agenda, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, or in written correspondence delivered to the Inyo County Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.

6. AMENDED CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 2014-01/711 MATERIALS, INC. - The applicant has submitted a request to amend CUP #2014-01 by extending the time period for one (1) year. Continued need to provide materials to the LADWP Owens Lake Dust Mitigation Project and other regional constructions projects has made it apparent to the applicant that contractual commitments will extend beyond the original two-year estimated

time-frame. This amendment to the existing CUP is Categorically Exempt from provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Class 1), pursuant to Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines. The current term of CUP #2014-01 will expire on February 26, 2016, if extension is not granted.

7. **GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT (GPA) NO. 2015-02 AND ZONE RECLASSIFICATION (ZR) NO. 2015-02/ EASTERN CALIFORNIA MUSEUM EXPANSION AND ASSOCIATED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (MND)** - the County proposes a GPA from “Open Space and Recreation (OSR)” to “Public Service Facilities Designation (PF)” and ZR from “Open Space – 40 acre minimum (OS-40)” to “Public (P)” to better reflect planned on site uses. The Eastern California Museum was established on land leased from the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power by the County of Inyo. The 9.40 acre lease is located at the corner of N. Grant and W. Market Street (Onion Valley Road) on the west side of the community of Independence. The Carson and Colorado Railroad under a Memorandum of Understanding with the County will construct a 40’foot by 74’foot Engine House and related track on the existing grounds of the Eastern California Museum to relocate and secure for restoration and display Engine 18 (Slim Princess) from Dehy Park. The Commission will consider recommending that the Board of Supervisors approve the project and adopt the MND.
